

LIMITED AWNING FABRIC WARRANTY

Fabrics from the “***WORLD of ELEGANCE***” collection offered by **ROLLTEC®** Rolling Systems LTD. are made from 100% solution dyed acrylic fiber, meaning the colour is locked-in to ensure a long lasting fabric life. Being a woven fabric, it “breathes”, thus allowing for some light to be diffused through the fabric. The awning fabric has a fluorocarbon Teflon® coating providing excellent water repellency.

The warranty takes effect from the date of purchase.

This high quality fabric is covered under warranty for a period of **(10) ten years*** and guarantees the fabric to be free of manufacturing defects, and protects fabric from becoming unserviceable due to unusual wear and tear resulting in loss of colour or strength under normal conditions. Damage from misuse or abuse, improper operation or maintenance, soiling or damage from animals or birds, the fall of objects on the fabric, cigarette burns, fireworks, flares or other fires, strong winds, hurricanes, snow, heavy rain, water pooling, hail or any other acts of God, improper use of detergents, chemical products or solvents, scrapers or abrasive brushes, or any other tools that may harm the fabric are not covered under this warranty. Any labour costs associated with installation by a dealer are not covered under this fabric warranty.

*During years one through eight (1-8), **ROLLTEC®** shall replace or repair the damaged fabric, free of cost to the consumer, as determined to be defective and not damaged as the result of misuse or abuse; at the then current selling price less a 30% discount in the ninth year (9th); and less a 15% discount during the tenth (10th) year. Costs associated with installation, labour and shipping are not covered under this fabric warranty.

Since awning valance and valance braid are subject to fraying due to greater interaction with the elements, the valance and braid are guaranteed for a period of **(1) one year**. **ROLLTEC®**, at its’ discretion, is limited to supply a new valance or to replace the portion of the valance that has become unserviceable.

CARE and CLEANING

The acrylic fabric does not promote mildew growth; however, mildew may grow on dirt and other foreign substances that are not removed from the fabric. One of the best ways to keep your fabric cover looking good and delay the need for a vigorous cleaning is to periodically perform regular maintenance (based on awning location and environmental conditions) before substances such as dirt, roof particles, etc. are allowed to accumulate and become embedded in the fabric. This also helps prevent staining from bird or animal droppings and fallen leaves.

This can be done by gently brushing off any loose dirt, debris etc., then hosing off the fabric with clear water (do not use a power washer as this may damage the fabric), you may use a solution of mild natural soap (ie. Ivory Snow® or Woolite®) and water, combined with a soft bristled brush or cloth to clean off any dirt. The water should be cold to lukewarm, (never more than 100°F or 35°C), rinse thoroughly to remove all soap then leave awning extended to allow sufficient time for air drying. **DO NOT USE HARSH DETERGENTS!**

Performing this minor maintenance regularly ensures a beautiful appearance and long lasting life of your fabric top.

For stubborn stains, you may add a small amount of bleach or Dawn® dish soap to the cleaning solution. Always, rinse well to remove all cleaning agents and allow sufficient time for air drying. Keep in mind that the use of bleach and/or advanced age of the fabric application may impact the deterioration of the sewing thread.
